Due to increases in both minimum wage and stock prices, combined with multiple COVID shutdowns, we are under pressure to do more business. We have continued to meet this challenge. To maintain this increase in business, and to grow in other areas, we desperately need more dedicated volunteers to come and help. We cannot rely solely on our Canteen and the gaming machines to keep us going. It takes these weekly recurring events which allows us to meet our obligations, without substantially increasing our prices across the board. No one likes price increases, and we don't want to implement them. Historically, we've had the same 5 to 7 volunteers who we keep having

to rely on during the week. Due to various reasons, some of these dedicated volunteers have had to step away. There's an old saying, "No one can do everything, but everyone can do something." This is where we are at right now. We need people to step up and volunteer to help with our various activities. Today we have 176 paid members in our Legion. If we could just get 15 or 20 to commit to volunteering at the Post a few hours a month, then we wouldn't have a shortage of help. Please, if you have the time available, get with one of the Post Officers and see where you can help out at. It will benefit our Post greatly, and ensure we are here for the next 100 years.
